

PERMANENT MAKEUP CONTRAINDICATIONS AND WAITING PERIODS

Contraindications for Procedure

- Nickel Allergy
- Pregnant / Nursing
- Chemotherapy and Radiation full treatment – prophylactic chemotherapy is generally safe to proceed
- Active dermatologic disorders, i.e. rosacea, eczema, psoriasis, shingles and cold sores.
- Sickness. (Due to the recent pandemic, we advise clients to refrain from scheduling if they aren't feeling well).
- Active Herpes Simplex Virus
- Hemophilia
- Lashes
- Accutane

Required Waiting Periods

- Botox or Disport - 1 day since they can't lay flat for 5 hours.
- Fillers i.e. Juvaderm, Silk, Voluma, Sculptra, etc. – 2 weeks
- Accutane full dose – one year (half dose or prophylactic needs medical clearance on a prescription pad)
- Sun tanned skin – 1 month
- Retinols, Glycolic acid, Vitamin C peels – 8 weeks
- Lasers, IPL – 8 weeks
- Shingles shot – 1 month
- Laser removal of old permanent makeup – 8 weeks
- Fish oil – stop 1 week prior

Eyeliner

- Lasik or Cataract Surgery : 1 month prior and 3 months post-op
- All lash serums including Latisse – 4 weeks off
- Lash extensions - 2 weeks off

Required Medical Clearance: Medical clearance is to be written on a prescription pad

- Heart valve, stents, pacemakers, rheumatic fever – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Organ transplants –medical clearance and pre medication
- Joint replacement – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Insulin dependent diabetic – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Fever blister history – pre-medication
- Shingles history – medical clearance and pre-medication, even with immunization
- Seizure – medical clearance
- Blood thinners, steroids – medical clearance
- Glaucoma – Medical clearance
- Lupus / Auto immune disease – medical clearance and pre-medication
- Graves' disease – Medical clearance
- Anxiety / Bipolar disorders – medical clearance
- Blepharitis –medical clearance
